Working to improve digital access for all.

Digital Support Derbyshire aims to map current digital inclusion initiatives across the county, engage with communities and partners to develop new projects, and foster collaboration among these initiatives by sharing best practices.

Research from the Civil Society has found that 22% of the UK population lack basic digital skills, and in rural areas, only 21% of households have superfast broadband availability - compared to 86% of urban households. Put simply, many people are at risk of being left behind.

APPLY FOR GRANTS

Digital Support Derbyshire offers a Small Grants Programme, allowing Network Members to apply for up to £4,000.

These grants support local providers of digital inclusion initiatives across Derbyshire, helping more residents become digitally included, connected, and confident.

JOIN OUR NETWORK

The Digital Support Derbyshire Network aims to tackle digital exclusion across the county by:

- Promoting the role of informal digital champions – friends, family and neighbours
- Partnering with other local organisations

- Have access to refurbished devices for your group or individuals you support

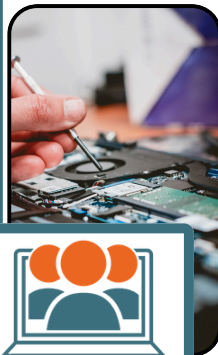
REFURBISHED DEVICES FOR YOUR PROJECT
